

# City of Alameda Health Care District Elects Jeff Cambra President



The Board of Directors of the City of Alameda Health Care District elected Jeff Cambra President of the Board at their January meeting. Mr. Cambra is a 40-year resident of Alameda and an East Bay native and has served on the Board of the District for the past 3 years. He originally sought a position on the District Board as a way to help preserve and secure the ongoing viability of Alameda Hospital and its emergency room for future generations, after experiencing first-hand the care his mother received there.

Mr. Cambra attended Chabot Community College, University of California -Davis, and the John F. Kennedy School of Law where he received his Juris Doctorate. He is a member in good standing of the California Bar Association and has advanced training in community-based mediation and facilitation of multistakeholder/multi-issue projects.

Mr. Cambra has owned and managed multiple businesses over the years including wholesale product distribution, customer direct sales manufacturing, and is currently the principal in a large-scale event production company. Jeff also provides pro bono legal services to Alameda residents and is an active member of the Alameda community through serving on numerous nonprofit boards including the League of Women Voters of Alameda, the Rotary Club of Alameda, Altarena Playhouse, and the Alameda Chamber of Commerce. He has served on the City of Alameda's Open Government Commission and the Rent Review Advisory Committee where he chaired the mediation panel. In 2024, he was elected the chair of Peralta Community College District Bond Measure Oversight Committee.
